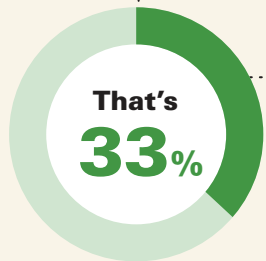


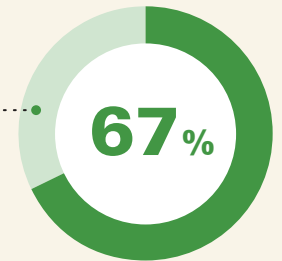
U.S. Forestry: By the Numbers

International Paper leads the world in responsible forest stewardship. Our actions create value for landowners, communities, customers and ecosystems on a global scale.

The U.S. has 766 million acres of forestland.

That's **513 million** acres of forestland

58% of total U.S. forestland is privately owned

11 million individual and family forest landowners make up the majority of private ownership

90% of the country's wood and paper products are provided by privately owned forests

International Paper supports **30 million** acres of working forest in the U.S.

Launched in 2013, the **Forestland Stewards** Partnership between International Paper and the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation protects and enhances ecologically important forestlands and coastal savannah in 10 southern states.
